

Requirements for submission of articles for publication on the journal “All about meat”.

1. The recommended volume of the materials:

Not less than 4 pages and not more than 7 pages in A4 format or 8000 to 24000 characters with spaces including tables and figures.

2. The format of the material:

- Use Microsoft Office Word;
- Font: Times New Roman
- The body of the article: size 14 pt (except Reference and Notes), interline spacing 1.
- Sources (Reference and Notes): size 12 pt
- - recommended symbols: quotation marks «...» (when highlighting inside quotations use another type of quotation marks, for example, «...“...”...»);
- A usual dash (–) is typed by simultaneous pressing keys Ctrl and Num Lock.

Materials could contain tables made in Microsoft Office Word. It is not permitted to use other programs for formatting tables.

3. Requirements to illustrations:

Figures, graphs and photos are accepted in digital format. Resolution - no less than 300 ppi. Illustrations should be in tif or jpg format saved with the highest quality. They should be sent to the editorial office by separate files; the name of the article should be indicated in the name of files. Illustrative material on paper could be rejected by the editorial staff because of its poor quality.

4. The layout of an article or other material (in compliance with the requirements of VAK RF contained in informational notice No 45.1-132 of 14.10.2008):

- The name of the article (at the left, first-line indent);
- Surname and initials of the author with indication of the academic degree, academic title and affiliation (at the left, first-line indent);
- Abstract (in Russian);
- Key words in Russian (no more than 10 words);

- Information about the scientific translation: the author and title in the original language, place, publishing house and the year of publication, number of pages or separate pages that correspond to the text of translation;
- The body of the article (or other material);
- Reference (sources);
- Notes (explanation references);
- Information about the author (surname, first name, patronymic, the academic degree, academic title, job title and affiliation, phone, e-mail, postal address).

5. Requirements to the structure of the text:

- Surname and initials of the author is to be in bold, lowercase type, size 14 pt, left-justified;
- Title of the article - in bold, size 16 pt;
- Section headings - in bold (without numeration);
- Subsection headings - in bold;
- Highlighting inside the text is made with usual italics (underlining of the words, as well as words typed in capital letters, bold type etc. are not allowed).
- Numbered list is given in general order (1, 2, 3 etc.; a), b), c) etc.) with each item beginning from the new paragraph.
- bullet list is acceptable only with dashes;
- References should be arranged in alphabetical order, and typed using size 12 pt at the end of the paper before notes. It is made according to GOST 7.1-2003. At the beginning of the list, the literature in Russian language is given following with the literature in foreign languages (see the example of composing the reference list);
- list of other sources (for example, web-sites and notes) should also be 12 pt and given using consecutive numbering immediately after reference;
- Information about the author is to be 12 pt in size.

6. Arrangement of references in the text of the article:

- References (to the literature) is printed inside the article in square brackets after a citation or at the end of the sentence before the period if indirect citations are used.
- References to several sources are separated with the symbol “;” (semicolon).

7. Related documents:

- 7.1. The contract for publication of the manuscript in the journal “All about meat”. The form of the contract is on website www.vniimp.ru.
- 7.2. A covering letter of the head of the organization where the author works with the request to publish an article. It is sent by fax or e-mail in the jpg or pdf format.

8. Other terms:

- 8.1. Manuscripts submitted to any other publication or already published are not to be submitted to the editorial office.
 - 8.2. Editorial board retains the right to shorten and edit the material of the paper.
 - 8.3. All materials of non-advertising nature including scientific works of candidates for a academic degree are published free of charge.
9. The language of originals sent for publication and covering letters is Russian.
